

Milwaukee Region PCA Concours Series Rules

The following rules apply to all concours events hosted by the Milwaukee Region. The Milwaukee Region runs a series of concours events. Milwaukee Region members can accumulate points over the course of a season by entering in one or more of these events.

Only Milwaukee Region members are eligible for region points, year-end points/awards. All entrants are eligible for individual awards.

At the first concours entered for the season, the entrant must determine the Class in which his/her car belongs on the basis of preparation and declare same at the time of registration.

Entrants must remain in the same Class originally entered, or move **up** a Class in subsequent events.

Once judging begins, no additional cars may be added to a Class.

One or more cars will be designated as a Class.

No bonus points will be awarded for authenticity and no penalty imposed for the lack thereof. Judging shall be based solely on the cleanliness and condition of the car.

Classes and points

Class	Defined as	Max points without age, mileage or driving points
A	Exterior, interior, trunk, engine, undercarriage	300
B	Exterior, interior, trunk, engine	235
C	Exterior, interior, trunk	180
D	Exterior, interior	134
E	Exterior, interior (visual inspection only)	40

Schedule of points leading to Year End Awards will be skewed in favor of the higher classes as shown:

Age and mileage points:

In addition to the maximum points per class, following points will be assigned for age and mileage as shown:

Age points will be awarded as shown with a maximum of 5 points allowed.

2002-Current = 0.0 points

1997-2001 = 0.5 points

1992-1996 = 1.0 points

1987-1991 = 1.5 points

1982-1986 = 2.0 points

1977-1981 = 2.5 points

1972-1976 = 3.0 points

1967-1971 = 3.5 points

1962-1966 = 4.0 points

1957-1961 = 4.5 points

1948-1956 = 5.0 points

Mileage points will be awarded as shown with a maximum of 5 points allowed.

Less than 10,000 miles = 0.0 points
10,000-20,000 miles = 0.5 points
20,001-30,000 miles = 1.0 points
30,001-40,000 miles = 1.5 points
40,001-50,000 miles = 2.0 points
50,001-60,000 miles = 2.5 points
60,001-70,000 miles = 3.0 points
70,001-80,000 miles = 3.5 points
80,001-90,000 miles = 4.0 points
90,001-100,000 miles = 4.5 points
Greater than 100,000 = 5.0 points

Driving points: Two bonus points will be awarded for cars that were driven to the event from the entrant's home on the day of the event and not trailered in any fashion.

A majority of First Place awards in any class by any one car/entrant during one Concours season shall result in that entrant's promotion to the next higher Concours Class for the next season.

Judging and award structure will be at the discretion of the Concours chairperson. Any and all protests will be considered on the basis of common sense, fairness and sportsmanship. In the absence of any of these, any and all protests will be ignored.

At the discretion of the event chairperson, additional awards, i.e. "People's Choice," "Best New Car," and "Judge's Choice" may be added to any event.
